Learning for Work

In addition to the courses listed in this brochure, the Adult Learning Service offer a range of flexible learning opportunities that are designed to support individuals to take their first steps back into learning and to assist them to progress to further learning, training, volunteering or employment.

These Welsh Government funded courses are offered free to learners and include a range of Digital courses as well as courses that assist with the development of skills for those looking for work in childcare, care, hospitality, customer services and retail.

Individuals aged 19 years and above who are eligible to enrol on these Learning for Work courses include:

- those who are not currently in education, training or employment and are in receipt of state benefits or support (excluding state retirement pension)
- those aged 50 plus who are not in full-time employment and who are actively seeking work.
- those who have no or few qualifications
- those referred by third sector organisations

If you want to enrol on one of these courses but you do not meet the eligibility criteria, then you can enrol by paying the fees listed on page 4 of this brochure. For more information on these courses please visit the website or contact 02920 872030.

Extra charges may apply for materials including paper, clay, glazes and firing, lead, glass and silver. This can vary depending on the size of your project.

REDUCED FEES

If you are entitled to a reduced fee you must show evidence of your benefits – either a recent DWP letter or bank statement, when you enrol in person or at your first class if enrolling by post or online.

You are entitled to a reduced fee if you are claiming any of the following benefits: State Pension Income Support/Pension Credit*, Working Tax Credit, Universal Credit, Job Seekers Allowance, Housing Benefit, Exceptionally Severe Disablement Allowance, Personal Independence Payment, Employment Support Allowance, Industrial Disablement Benefit, Carers' Allowance, Incapacity Benefit, Council Tax Benefit Reduction** or if you are a Full Time Student.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

You are not entitled to attend a course unless you have paid in advance.

The Council reserves the right to cancel or limit the length of courses, or change the date, time or location of classes. In the event of a change you will be notified. Learners will be entitled to a full or partial refund in the event of course closure. Refunds are only given in exceptional circumstances and only within the first two weeks of the course starting. Refunds are subject to an admin fee.

If you are studying a language, your tutor will check you are in the most suitable class for your level – they will inform you if you need to move to another class (you can then decide to move, or to be refunded). The tutor's decision **must** be adhered to.

Whilst every effort is made to fire all pottery and fused glass work, we do not guarantee this will be completed straight away. We are not responsible for loss or damage to work due to the rigours of the firing process. We do not offer refunds for delays in firing. We ask learners only to put work to be fired if they plan to complete it and take it away once finished. Work left at the end of term will be disposed of – unless storage has been agreed in advance. We can take no responsibility for loss or damage to any work, tools or equipment stored in Llanover.

Some of our classes such as Stained Glass and Jewellery require the use of tools and equipment and working with materials that could cause injury if not used correctly – these classes may not be suitable for all learners and we will direct these learners to more suitable classes. If a class has to be cancelled at short notice, we will try to contact you – please make sure we have your correct contact details when you enrol.

Parking is limited at most venues – unfortunately we can't create more parking spaces. Where possible, please walk, cycle, use public transport, or car share. Vehicles are parked at owners' risk.




